

PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR STOOL CULTURE AND SHIGA TOXIN COLLECTION

Dear Patient:

You have been asked by your physician to collect a stool specimen. Please read and follow the instructions provided below.

One (1) fecal swab kit has been provided for collection.

- 1. Stool specimens can be passed into a clean, dry container or onto a clean paper.
- 2. Collect a small amount of sample by rotating swab tip to cover it with stool. Avoid touching the swab applicator below the pink molded breakpoint.
- 3. Remove cap from the tube and insert the swab to the bottom of the tube.
- 4. Mash and mix stool specimen against the side of the tube to disperse.
- 5. Holding the tube away from face, grasp the end of swab shaft and bend at a 180 degree angle to break at the pink breakpoint. If needed, gently rotate the swab shaft to complete the breakage.
- 6. Screw the cap on tightly to prevent leakage.
- 7. Label tube with patient information including Last name, First name, and Date of Birth.
- 8. It is important to indicate date and time of stool passage and write this on Fecal Swab collection kit.
- 9. Return specimen to lab within 48 hours of collection.

PLEASE NOTE:

- STOOL SPECIMENS TRANSFERRED FROM THE TOILET BOWL TO THE CONTAINER ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- STOOL SPECIMENS MIXED WITH URINE, RESIDUAL SOAP, OR DISINFECTANTS ARE ALSO NOT ACCEPTABLE.
